And as you can see the pictures are getting rather wide as Howard and Bill work on the trim pieces just after the second wing was fitted for the first time



Bill finished of the front trim section between the wing and the front screen as I attempt to make a new strip to secure in the windscreen at the bottom



Last week the concentration was on the floats as the patch was secured back on with rivets and sealed with 5200 one messy job!

So what's happening next? The wing will be popped back off now we know they fit and the trim pieces have been fabricated the fuselage will be cleaned again while the last few dents are repaired on the wings. Though were getting close to paint

The floats need to be assembled and components made to secure the struts that attach the floats to the plan.
